CEAT Brings Road Safety Session to the Roads of Daman

28th March, 2017, Daman: With an aim to promote awareness on road safety, CEAT, the Indian Tyre manufacturing giant organized a Road Safety Session in association with Indian Motorcycling Academy (IMA) on 25th March 2017 at Daman.
